Bevington heads to Moscow for Asia-Pacific Parliamentary Forum

Yellowknife, NT, January 18, 2006 – Western Arctic NDP Member of Parliament Dennis Bevington joins three Conservative and two Liberal MPs at the 15th Annual Asia-Pacific Parliamentary Forum in Moscow, Russia January 22-25.

The Canadian delegation will engage in international debates on issues such as International Trade; Climate Change; Combatting Terrorism, Drug Trafficking and Organized Crime; Strengthening Regional and Global Economic Co-operation; and Securing Peace and Stability in the Asia-Pacific Region.

“As the New Democratic Party’s Critic for Energy, I am especially interested in participating in discussions about Energy Security. Specifically, I am concerned about the proposed liquified natural gas supply from Russia in relation to how it could affect the future of our nation’s energy supply,” said Bevington.

Bevington will depart Yellowknife for Moscow on January 19.
