## NEW DEMOCRAT TASKFORCE ON ECONOMIC RECOVERY CONSULTS IN NWT

**Yellowknife, NT**– Western Arctic MP Dennis Bevington and Hamilton Mountain MP Chris Charlton, Co-Chair of the New Democrat Taskforce on Economic Recovery consulted with Yellowknifers, Northern business owners and community leaders in the capital of the NWT today.

"Stephen Harper is failing the North and Canada " said Charlton.

"I am in Yellowknife to listen to the concerns and ideas of the hard working folks who are being left behind by the Conservatives in this economic crisis," added Charlton.
